No helmet can protect the wearer against every possible impact.

- The helmet is designed to be held in place by its strap on the lower jaw.
- For a helmet to be effective, it must fit and be worn correctly. To check that it fits correctly, put it on and make any adjustments. Close the retention system. Grasp the helmet and try to turn it forwards and backwards. A correctly fitting helmet should be comfortable and should not move forward where it obstructs vision or backward so that the forehead is no longer protected.



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- Helmets with integrated attachment points are intended for cameras, light sources and similar objects that are compatible with the attachment.
- For helmets that do not have integrated attachment points, no objects should be attached to the helmet.
- The helmet is designed to absorb an impact by partially destroying the outer shell and the inner shell. This damage may not be visible. Therefore, the helmet should be destroyed if it has been exposed to an impact, even if it looks undamaged.
- The helmet can be destroyed by petroleum and petroleum products, cleaning agents, paints, adhesives and similar factors without any damage being visible to the user.
- A helmet has a limited service life and should be replaced if it shows obvious signs of wear.
- This helmet must not be worn by children when climbing or other activities where there is a risk of suffocation or hanging if the children become trapped while wearing the helmet.
- Depending on the type of impact, an accident can lead to serious or even fatal head injuries even at low speeds despite wearing a helmet. This helmet is designed to protect the head; it cannot protect against injuries to the neck and other parts of the body in the event of an accident. Every accident is different, so it is not possible to say with certainty whether a particular helmet will provide sufficient protection in every accident. Some helmets have flattened parts of the lower rim; these thinner sections may offer less protection than thicker helmet parts.
- Be careful and always exercise good judgment when riding. Obey all traffic laws and do your part to avoid accidents of any kind. Do not make any adjustments to the helmet or helmet components while riding, as this can lead to accidents.
- This helmet is only suitable for cyclists, skateboarders and roller skaters, as indicated on the label inside the helmet. It is not intended for use in motor sports, on motorcycles, on mopeds or other uses.
- This helmet may not be suitable for extreme riding with jumps or high speed.
